The **Education Development Officer** will deliver the education element of the Foundation's Football and Education programme, ensuring planning, teaching and assessment are to the expected high standards.

OBJECTIVES

- To plan and deliver engaging and informative lessons for BTEC modules utilising Norwich City Football Club where possible
- To ensure marking is accurate and up-to-date, with relevant feedback provided to scholars to aid their development and progression
- To support students in obtaining their first choice exit routes

ROLE SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- To successfully deliver the Level 3 Extended Diploma in Sport elements to selected cohorts of the Football and Education programme
- To identify resources attached to Norwich City Football Club and CSF that make lessons more engaging, informative and work-related
- To ensure all candidate portfolios are constantly monitored and the desired standards of work are being achieved
- To produce lesson-planning material to the expected standards that can be shared with other tutors delivering on the programme
- To act as a point of support for other scholars within the Foundation
- To act as the first point of call to students for pastoral and wellbeing support
- To support students with compiling UCAS and other relevant exit route applications where applicable
- To provide accurate and informative feedback to parents during the scholar review meetings
- To work with the Football Development Manager (16-19) to monitor students progress and eligibility for fixtures and training
- To support the implementation of an effective recruitment plan for future cohorts of scholars
