Canary Cup returns for 2025!**

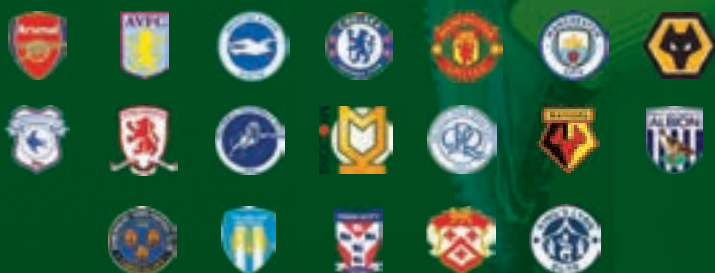
Taking place over the summer, the tournament is

At a glance

Facilities include:

Two 11-a-side 3G pitches, seven grass football pitches, dining facilities and canteen, meeting rooms, analysis and IT suites, classrooms and outdoor Challenge Woods area.

Travel:

The Nest is located next to Norwich International Airport and is a 20-minute drive from Norwich train station (direct links to London and Cambridge 90 mins)

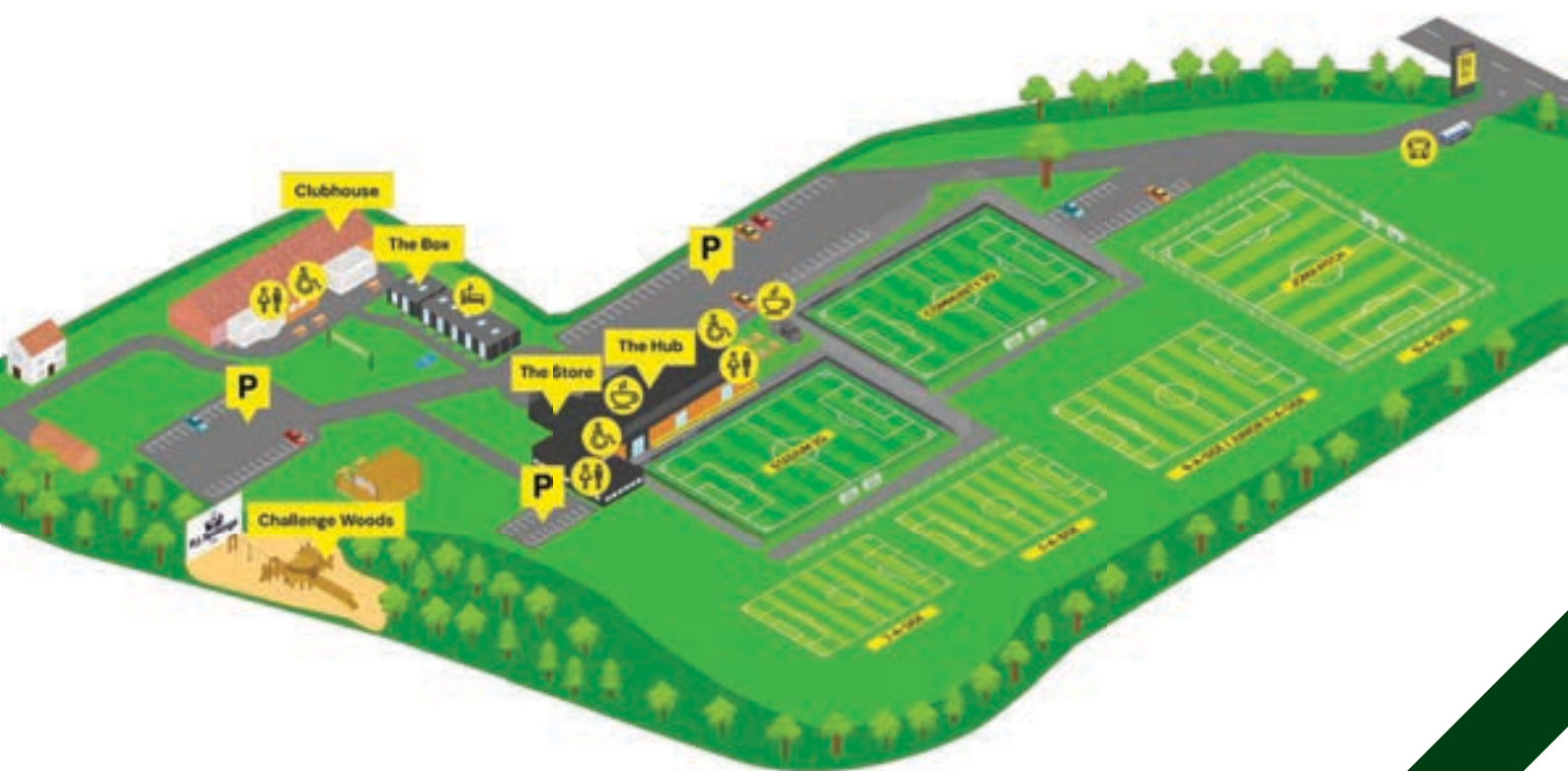
Accommodation:

Five bunkboxes sleep up to 14 each (a total of 70 individuals)

Located on the outskirts of Norwich, The Nest is the Foundation's state-of-the-art community hub.

The multi-million pound site contains high-quality football pitches, residential bunk boxes, cafes, conference, and event spaces, all set in a green and leafy secure 22-acre site.

It's perfectly positioned for trips into the historic city of Norwich and the beautiful North Norfolk countryside and coastline.



Location

The Nest is a short ten-minute drive from Norwich city centre, and fifteen minutes from the main train station, which has hourly trains to London and Cambridge.
